- a) Revised National Planning Policy Framework – *correspondence has been sent to all councillors.*
- b) Temporary closure of Stratford Tony Road, Coombe Bissett, from its junction with Drove Lane to the entrance of Northfield House. Alternative route is via C12 – C320, Race Plain Road – A3094 – A354, Stratford Tony Road. This will come into effect on 02 November 2021 from 09.30 – 15.30 for 1 day.
- c) From Mr Philip Hutchins of South Wiltshire Ramblers Group – Light Gang Cordinator. The restricted byway running from Homington Road to meet the Avon Valley Trail just below Dogdean Farm (BRIT11) had been reported as very overgrown and they were planning to start clearing it.
